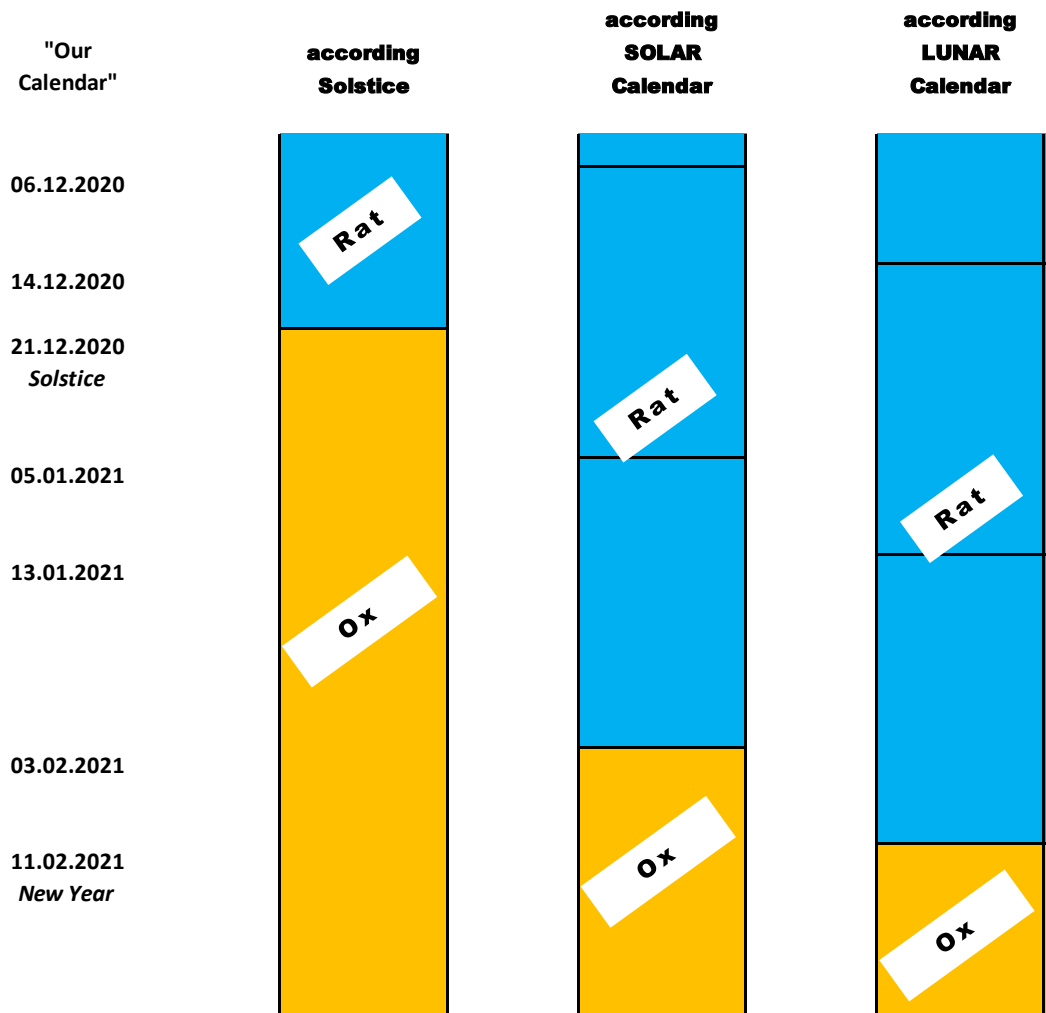

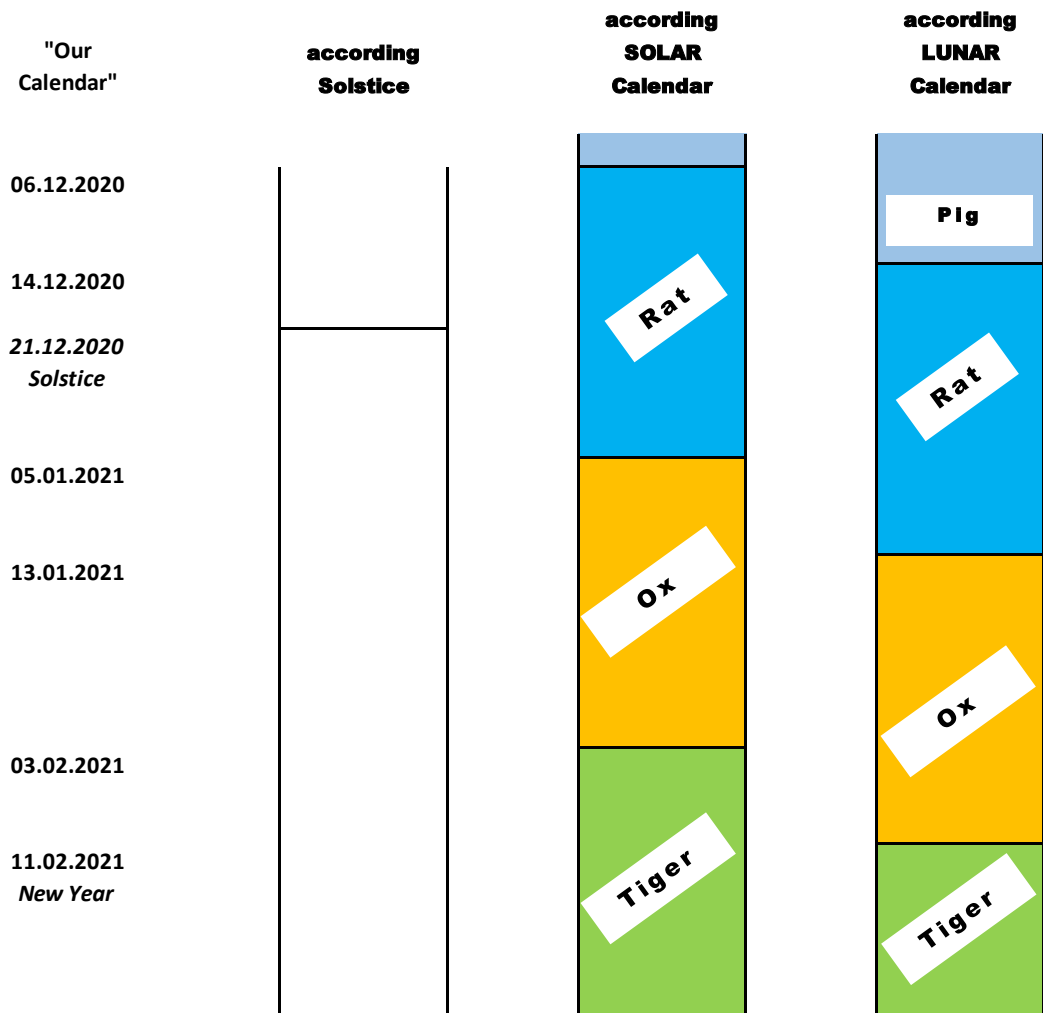
### Changing of the Year

(Days according CET)







**Changing of the Months**

### Annotation:

Date and time for solstice in the solar calendar as well as the new moon in the lunar calendar are precisely defined by astronomy and can be checked at the Internet, for example by the link above.

Unfortunately enough there are printed versions of the Chinese Calendar around, which are definitely wrong. (Variation of one/two minutes may be caused technically and that's ok, but not more.)
